Benefits to Hungry and Homeless People

In 2023, Samaritan Ministries served 107,011 meals and provided shelter to 452 different men throughout the year. On July 16, we served our 5 Millionth meal! It takes only \$3.66 to provide a meal in our Soup Kitchen and only \$44.66 to provide a night of shelter (plus breakfast and dinner) for a homeless man.

About SAM & Eggs

Since 2006, SAM & Eggs has provided significant financial support for Samaritan Ministries. The goal for 2024 is \$225,000. All money raised stays in the community to help hungry and homeless people. Tables are filled by both corporate sponsors and individual table captains. The event program includes testimonials by Samaritan guests as well as an invitation for everyone to give generously. A special emphasis is placed on recruiting Good Samaritan Society members who make \$1,000 commitments at the event. All giving levels are welcome and appreciated.
